# This month's program:

### **Marc Better**

## On the Move with Orchids: Something in Bloom All Year

Marc Better is an orchid hobbyist who has been growing plants in both northern and southern California for more than 30 years. Marc moved to Ventura with his orchid collection in 2018 and constructed a lath house in his yard, where he takes advantage of the temperate climate to grow plants near the beach. Marc will talk about the challenges and opportunities of moving a plant collection up, down and across the state to keep up with his career in biotechnology, and how the local environment influences the variety of orchids that can prosper. Over the years Marc has had greenhouses in three separate locations, but now prefers to navigate the challenges of local weather with an outdoor collection. He will offer a few tips on how to select plants that suit the local environment and how to ensure that with proper care there are flowers throughout the year. Marc holds a PhD in Biochemistry, and he is a past president of the South Bay Orchid Society and the Southland Orchid Show Committee. Marc currently serves on the Board of the Malibu Orchid Society.
